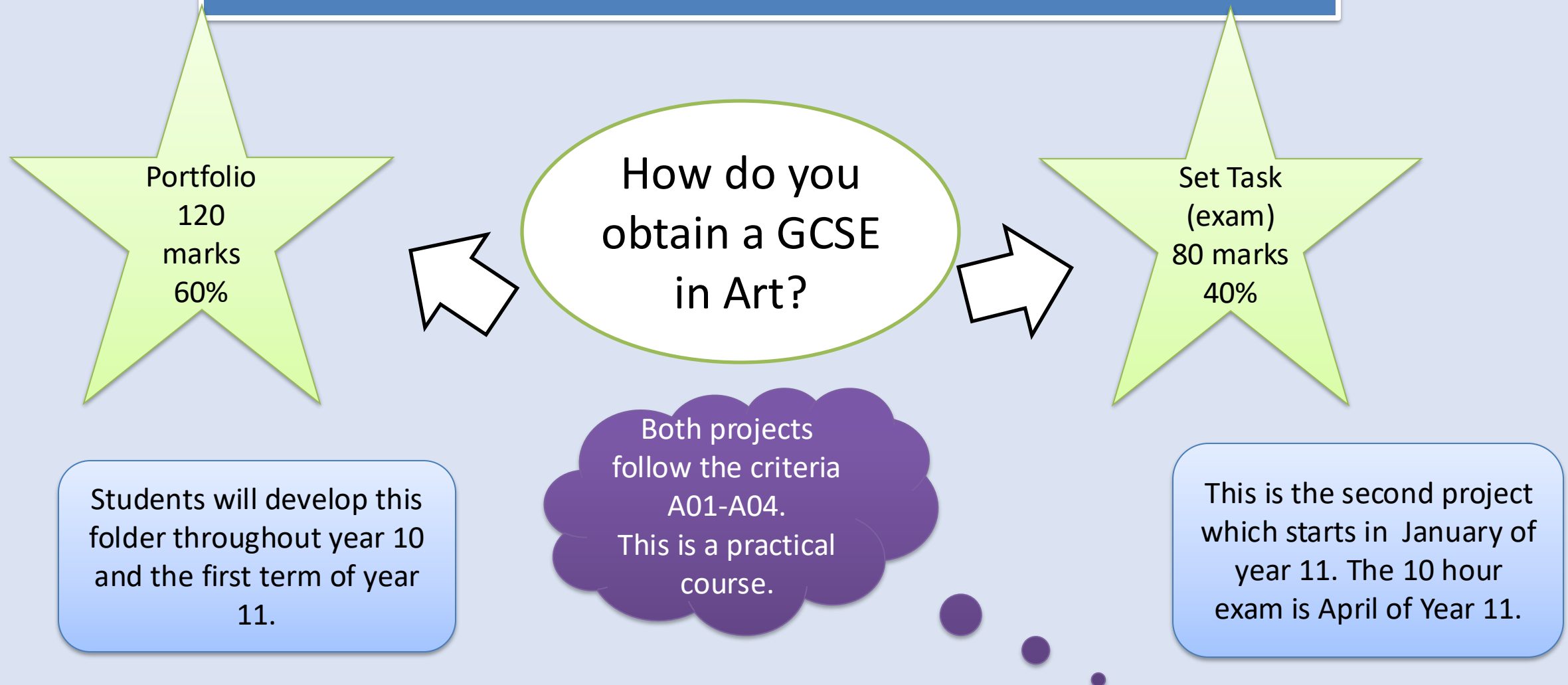

Success in Art:

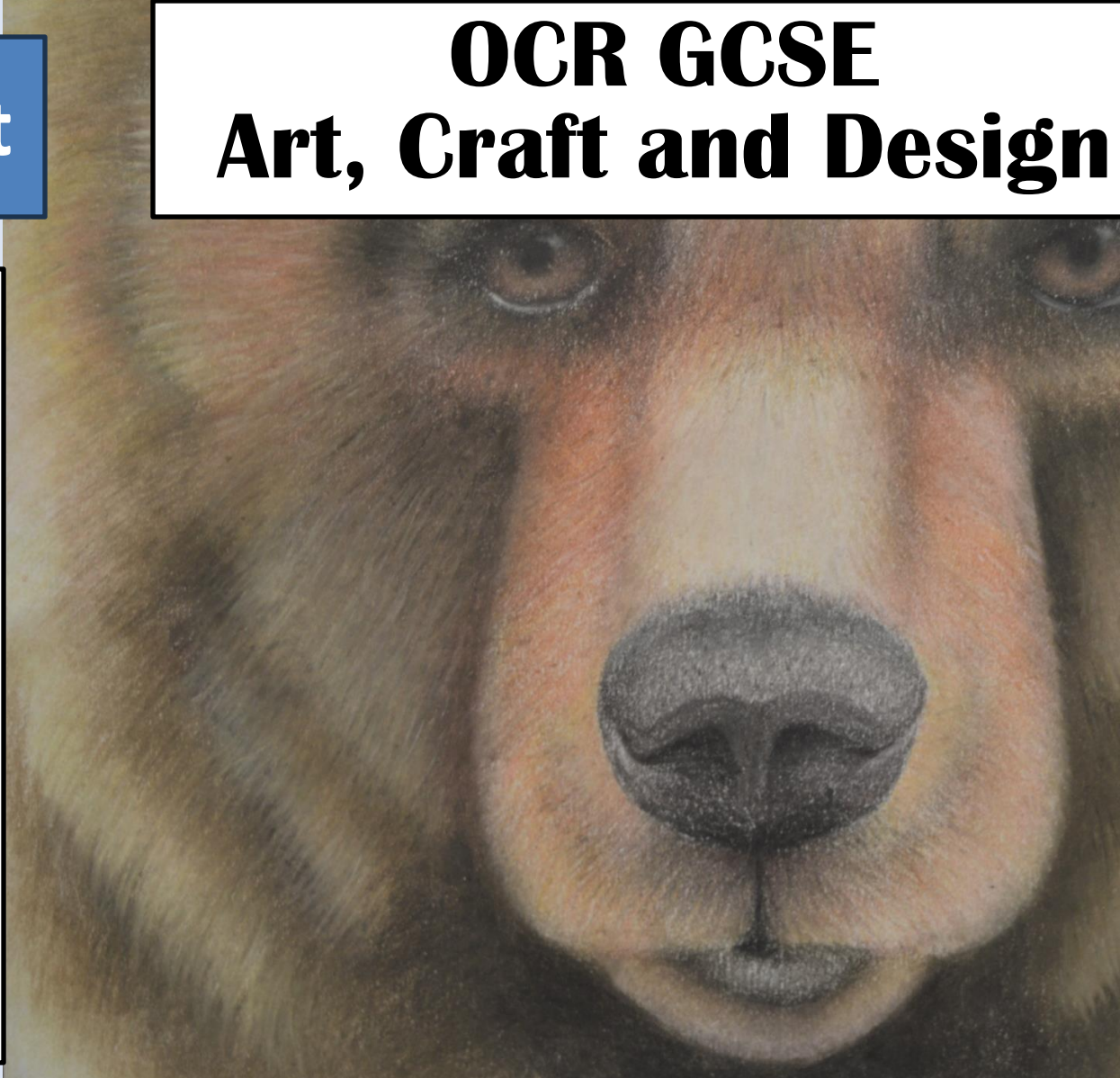
To be successful in Art, students need to:
